


This newsletter is to celebrate and share some of the learning that Reception has been doing over this half term.

We tasted porridge and compared how many children liked it and did not like it, we created the characters from the story using playdough and the creative area.


















We have been learning about different celebrations such as Christmas and Diwali. creating rangoli patterns, cards and divas.
