We have a small selection of pre-loved uniform for sale. This is uniform that parents have donated to us when their child has outgrown them. All the items have been washed and ironed and are available to purchase from the school office.

Non-uniform / mufti day

There may be times during the school year when your child can come to school in their own clothes. This may be for a charity or creative day event and may require a small donation

Lost n found

Please check the lost n found box located in the school office for lost or misplaced uniform.

Book bag / School bag

Please ensure that children from Nursery to Year 3 have a school book bag. KS2 children should bring a small back pack bag. This should fit easily into their named box outside their class.

PE / Swimming

Ensure your child brings their PE kit or swimming kit to school on the correct day of their activity. *All swimming classes take place on Friday.*

Introduction

Camrose is an average size two form entry primary school with a Nursery. As a Rights Respecting school, our ethos is built around the rights of our pupils and the importance of being respectful and considerate towards each other.

Senior Leadership Team (SLT)

Every morning the Head Teacher, Deputy Head, Learning Mentor and SENCO welcome the children into school. Class teachers are available at the start and end of the school day and are happy to talk to you at these times.

At Camrose we have an open door policy so you can ask to see the Head Teacher at anytime.

Contact details

You *must* provide the school with *two contact details for your child.* This should include: phone numbers, names and email addresses. It is vital that you provide the school with *up-to-date contact details* so if these change please notify the school *immediately*. This is to ensure we can contact you in emergencies as well as to share school communications with you.

Absence / late pickup

If your child is going to be absent or collected late from school, please telephone the school and inform the school office.

Your child will be marked as late for school if they arrive after 8:50am.

Parent Portal

The Parent portal is our main communication tool for parents. Through this App you can access the school calendar, newsletters and see your child's attendance, progress reports, letters and receive emails. *Please ensure we have your most recent email address*. We send most letters by email, please check your emails daily. If we need a response to a letter this will be sent on YELLOW paper home with your child,

Reporting to Parents

Progress will be share with parents during Parents' consultations in October and February so that they can see the areas where children are meeting expectations and, where they are ot, to be able to support children at home.

At the end of each term, we will report to parents, in the form of a written up-date, to inform parents that children are either below, inline or exceeding expectations in relation to both progress and attainment.

<u>Clubs</u>

- Breakfast club Every morning from **8am** for £1 per child.
- After school each term there are an extensive range of clubs offered on a first come first serve basis. There are some clubs where Teachers personally invite children to attend. Most clubs are free but some have a cost so please enquire with the school office.

Children *must* be collected on time from an after school club .

Break time & Lunch

All children have a 15 minute break in the morning. In EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 a fruit snack is provided.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive free school meals; if your child is in Years 3-6 you will need to pay, £16 per week. School dinners will be for the whole half term. If you wish to change to packed lunches after the half term break, let the office know.

If you are receiving any benefits, please inform the office as you may be entitled to a uniform voucher the following year, and Free School Meals for your child.

Water & Snacks

Please ensure your child has a water bottle, clearly labelled with their name. Only healthy snacks are permitted.

Toilets

Children have access to toilets throughout the school day and are encouraged to go at break and lunchtime so as not to affect learning time.

Homework

Children are expected to read everyday with their parent and complete their online homework on Google Classroom.

All children receive weekly homework on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. If you are unsure how to help your child with their homework please speak to the class teacher or one of our PEP volunteers.

<u>Trips</u>

Throughout the year there are a number of class trips arranged. We aim to book trips with minimal costs to parents but if these trips are not paid for then we have no choice but to cancel them.

Welfare / medicines

At Camrose we have a dedicated person responsible for welfare throughout the day. Please note, we can only administer medicine that has been prescribed by a Dr and which is in English.
