<b>KS2 Cohort Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 29 pupils on role aged 10/11 years</li> <li>• 28 eligible pupils on role at time of tests</li> <li>• 1 pupil disapplied due to no English so count for SATs was 28 pupils</li> <li>• 3 pupils, 10% of cohort, eligible pupils with SEND.</li> <li>• 10 pupils, 34% of cohort, classified as disadvantaged.</li> <li>• No CLA pupils</li> <li>• 23 pupils, 82% of cohort, with English as an Additional Language.</li> <li>• From the cohort of 29 only 23 attended Camrose at the end of KS1; there are no prior results for 6 pupils.</li> <li>• KS1 APS 16.7 for this cohort; in line with NA</li> <li>• 17% started KS2 below expected level</li> <li>• 35% started KS2 at expected level</li> <li>• 48% started KS2 higher than expected level</li> </ul>
