



What we will be learning this half term

<p>READING</p> <p>Pupils will read Handa's Surprise</p> <p>Pupils will be applying their phonic knowledge and skills to decode words and read aloud accurately</p> <p>Reading Comprehension Pupils will develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read and develop a range of strategies to understand book they read.</p>	<p>How to help at home</p> <p>Ask your child about the books they are reading Use question words when discussing books; who, what, why, where, when how. Listen to your child read daily</p> <p>Ensure your child regularly logs in to Reading Eggs at home.</p>
<p>WRITING</p> <p>Pupils will write recounts of stories they have listened to and write character descriptions.</p> <p>They will be covering: Phonics Phase 4 (consonant blends) Nouns Verbs Adjectives Conjunctions Capital letters Full stops Exclamation marks Question marks</p>	<p>How to help at home</p> <p>Get your child to practice writing descriptions at home</p> <p>Encourage them to write sentences using the grammar listed opposite</p>
<p>MATHEMATICS</p> <p>This half term pupils will learn about: Number and place value; numbers up to 100 Addition, subtraction; 1 more than, 1 less than; calculations with numbers up to 30 Multiplication; doubling Properties of common 2D and 3D shapes</p>	<p>How to help at home</p> <p>Practice recognising, counting and writing numbers to 100</p> <p>Give them + and – sums to practice at home</p>
<p>SCIENCE</p> <p>The focus this half term will be Our Senses Pupils will learn the names of the main body parts (including head, neck, arms, elbows, legs, knees, face, ears, eyes, hair, mouth, teeth) through games, actions, songs and rhymes and to identify which part of the body is associated with each sense.</p>	<p>How to help at home</p> <p>Ask your child what they have been learning</p> <p>Play games that involve senses and parts of the body – ask pupils to name and explain</p>

COMPUTING	How to help at home
This half term pupils will be learning about what coding is and using a program to make objects to move	Talk to your child about what they are doing at school. Let them carry out various online coding games and activities

RE	PHSE
Pupils will explore Sikhism They will learn about places and objects special to Sikhs and think about what is special to them and why	<u>Being Me in My World</u> Pupils will learn about their rights and responsibilities for being a member of the class / school and recognise the choices they make and understand the consequences.

<u>Art</u> Pupils will be exploring/experimenting with a wide range of techniques using colour, pattern, texture, form and shape through drawing, painting, and sculpture.	<u>Movement Skills:</u> Pupils will be developing an understanding of how to dodge, run, balance, hop and jump on the spot and forwards as well as when to slow down, speed up or change direction to negotiate space successfully <u>Gymnastics:</u> This half term pupils will develop a good understanding of how to move on the floor: hop, skip, leap and how to apply good posture for all body shapes. They will practice negotiating space successfully, adjusting speed or changing direction.
