



What we will be learning this half term

READING	How to help at home
<p>Phonics Children will be learning how to read words with alternative sounds. They will also be reviewing Phase 5 sounds to prepare them for the Phonics Screening Check in June.</p> <p>Reading Comprehension Pupils will be reading texts and answering questions independently. Types of questions include: multiple choice, true or false, matching and sequencing.</p>	<p>Ensure your child regularly logs in to e-books at home</p> <p>Listen to your child read daily and ask questions to check for understanding</p> <p>Complete weekly English Homework on Google Classroom</p>
WRITING	How to help at home
<p>Pupils will be planning and writing their own stories about Sally the Strawberry. Sally lives a healthy lifestyle but one day she meets a very unhealthy class. How will she help them?</p> <p>Pupils will also start learning how to join some of their letters.</p> <p>They will be covering: Prefix un- Capital letters for names of people and places Alternative spellings (silent letters)</p>	<p>Practise weekly spellings</p> <p>Practise neat handwriting</p> <p>Practise writing sentences beginning with a capital letter, finger spaces and ending with full stop</p> <p>Complete weekly English Homework on Google Classroom</p>
MATHEMATICS	How to help at home
<p>This half term, pupils will learn about: Position and Direction Division using concrete materials Fractions $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ Reading and writing time</p>	<p>Recognise, find and name a quarter or half of an object, shape or quantity.</p> <p>Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.</p>
SCIENCE	How to help at home
<p>This half term children will be working scientifically to complete various experiments.</p>	<p>Try the experiments at home as they will be posted on Google Classroom</p>
COMPUTING	How to help at home
<p>This half term, children will learn how to word process using MS Word. They will learn how to use the mouse and keyboard to type text with capital letters and symbols. They will learn how to format text to change the font, size and colour.</p>	<p>Practise these skills on MS Word or Google Docs.</p>

RE	PHSE
Pupils will learn about Christianity. They will learn what Jesus teaches us through his parables for example to have faith, trust and belief.	Pupils will learn about relationships. They will identify the members of their family and understand that there are lots of different types of families.
ART & DT	PE
In Art children will learn about the painter Georgia O'Keefe and will produce art based on her work.	<u>Athletics</u> Children will experiment with different ways of moving (run, jump, hurdle and throw). <u>Bat and Racquet Skills</u> Children will learn to control a small ball by striking, catching or throwing it in a general direction.
Music	Humanities
Children will sing simple songs from memory and begin to show a sense of pulse and rhythm when performing.	In Geography children will be learning about identify daily and seasonal weather patterns using appropriate vocabulary e.g. temperature, rain, wind, sunshine. They will be able to confidently talk about /describe different types of weather and how it effects everyday life.
