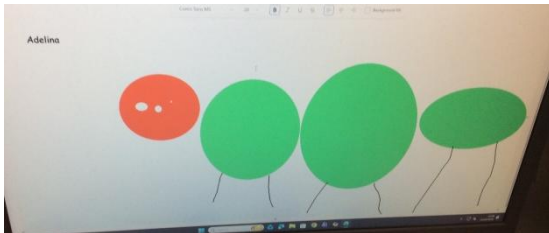
This newsletter is to celebrate and share some of the learning that Reception has been doing over this half term.

We have been learning how to create caterpillars using the mouse in computing, look at our amazing



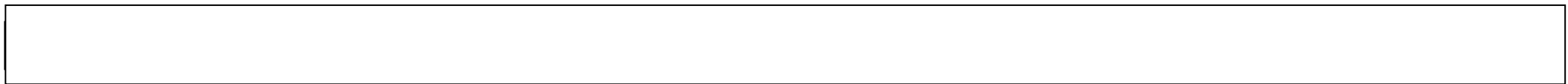
We have been learning about 3d shapes and checking which ones can roll or slide and talking about the features they have.

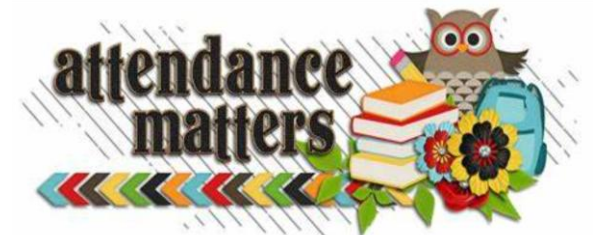
We have lots more children with 100% attendance this half term which is AMAZING! Well Done!

Congratulations to you all - keep it up, let's hope that we have even more children next half term! 😊

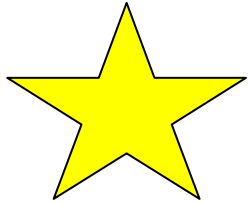

Let's work together to improve the attendance of all the Reception children.

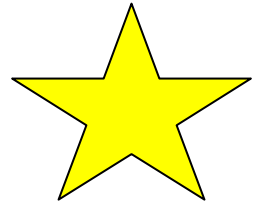

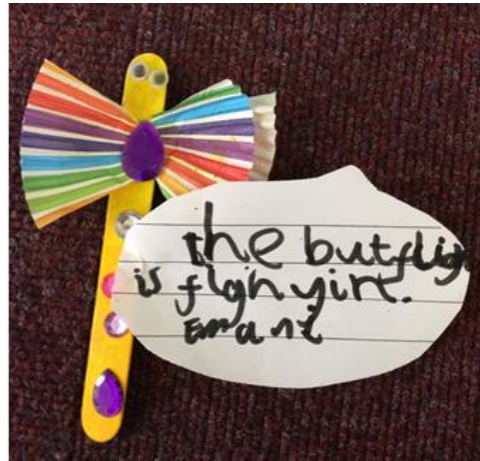
