Hedgehogs – using potatoes and wooden sticks.



We have been learning about Oral hygiene and learning how to brush our teeth properly. We have been brushing our teeth every day in school with support from our teachers.



We have been developing our fine motor skills and we using plastic knives to cut up fruit to make a fruit salad. We learnt how to use the plastic knives safely.



We learnt about 'Remembrance Day' and why it is celebrated. We created poppies to remember the soldiers who died or were injured in the war.




The afternoon Nursery children have been enjoying their sessions with Creative Futures expressing themselves through Music and Art.

Excellent attendance promotes good outcomes for children.




Photos from our Christmas Craft event
