Our topic has been Transport


We have had a very busy and exciting half term! The children have been learning lots and enjoying their experiences at school.

We celebrated Valentine's Day by creating hearts for our families.


In Maths we have been learning about patterns. We have been practising our counting skills by matching an amount to a number.

heart-shaped cookies






Attendance Matters

It is vital that your child attends Nursery every day.
Excellent attendance promotes good outcomes for children.

95%	=	47 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 8 days in total or 1 week and 3 days	ATTENDANCE MATTERS WHAT DO YOUR ATTENDANCE FIGURES ACTUALLY MEAN?
90%	=	95 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 16 days in total or 3 weeks and 1 day	
85%	=	142 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 24 days in total or 4 weeks and 4 days	
80%	=	190 LESSONS MISSED EACH YEAR 32 days in total or 6 weeks and 2 days
