A Huge Welcome Back!

Dear Parent / Carers,

I'd like to welcome you all back to Camrose Primary. I hope you had an enjoyable and safe summer break.

As we return to a more 'normal' routine, I'd like to assure you that, within the school walls, steps remain in place to maintain safety such as hand sanitiser stations, regular hand-washing, workstation cleaning, limiting the movement of children in school and staggered break and lunch times to avoid very large groups gathering.

In an effort to ensure the school day is 'normal' for you, I have reintroduced the soft start so pupils arrive and go straight to class between 8.30am and 8.50am.

Arrivals after 8.50 will be classified as late.

Home time will be **3.10pm** for EYFS and Year 1 and 2 pupils and **3.20pm** for Years 3 – 6.

EYFS parents please collect your child from the EYFS play area gate.

All other pupils need to be collected from the playground.

Please remember:

Please DO NOT send you child to school if they display any signs of Covid-19:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

The school WILL refuse entry to any pupil, staff, parent or visitor displaying any of these symptoms.
