#### Dear Parent / Carers

As we enter cold and flu season, it is vital that you do not send your child into school if they are unwell. A sniffle or runny nose is expected and fine but if your child is consistently coughing, has headaches or a temperature, then they need to remain at home.

### Please remember:

DO NOT send you child to school if they display any signs of Covid-19:

- a high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

The school WILL refuse entry to any pupil, staff, parent or visitor displaying any of these symptoms.

If your child has any medical needs i.e. asthma, that you have not made us aware of, please can you give the details to the school office. Thank you.
