



Remote learning Home—School Agreement

School will...

- Provide daily lessons that directly reflect the normal 'in class' teaching and learning as much as possible
- Provide a mixture of instructional lessons, independent activities, and other relevant tasks (i.e on Mathletics, Times Table Rockstars) to continue learning at home
- Provide feedback on completed assignments/tasks through Google Classroom within 36 hours of it being 'turned in'
- The remote learning work that pupils turn in will be used to assess learning
- Provide appropriate tasks for pupils who have an EHCP
- Contact pupils who do not log in or complete tasks to check in on them and their family
- Offer pupils the opportunity to ask for extra help if they don't understand; the teacher will respond via Google classroom messaging facility within 24 hours
- Behavioural issues, such as failing to complete work shall be dealt with through discussions with parents over the phone

Pupils will...

- Be contactable during the school day – although they may not always be in front of a device the entire time
- Complete work to the deadline set by teachers
- Seek help if they need it, from teachers or teaching assistants via Google Class messaging
- Alert teachers if they're not able to complete work
- Maintain the high standards of behaviour expected at school
- Be courteous when messaging adults

Parents / Carers will ...

- To ensure their child is following the daily timetable and completing their work, to avoid more learning time loss
- Let the school know if their child has any technical issues with accessing online learning during isolation
- Report any absences—including COVID 19 symptoms or positive test results for the child or someone within the household
- Ensure their child only uses the platforms for educational purposes
- Monitoring the use of their devices for access of other online materials and apps
- Be respectful when making any complaints or concerns known to staff
