KS2 Cohort Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 pupils on role aged 10/11 years • 27 eligible pupils on role at time of tests • 3 pupils disappled due to no English so count for SATs was 27 pupils • 7 pupils, 23% of cohort, eligible pupils with SEN; 6 pupils on school support or being monitored – 1 pupil with a statement. • 11 pupils, 37% of cohort, eligible for FSM • No CLA pupils • 26 pupils, 87% of cohort, with English as an Additional Language. • From the cohort of 30 only 21 attended Camrose at the end of KS1; there are no prior results for 9 pupils. • KS1 APS 13.2 for this cohort; significantly below National Average • 29% started KS2 below expected level • 57% started KS2 at expected level • 14% started KS2 higher than expected level
Progress Measures - Reading	<p>From the eligible pupils (21 pupils):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21 pupils, 90%, achieved at least expected progress in Reading, in line with NA of 91%. ❖ Low attainers: 6 pupils, 100% made at least expected progress in Reading, above NA of 80%. ❖ Middle attainers: 12 pupils, 83% made at least expected progress in Reading, below the NA of 95%. ❖ High attainers: 3 pupils, 100% made at least expected progress in Reading, above NA of 92%. <p>From eligible pupils: 21 pupil 24% made more than expected progress; this is below the Nat Ave of 33%</p>
Progress Measure – Math	<p>From the eligible pupils:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 22 pupils, 86%, achieved at least expected progress in mathematics, this is below the NA of 90% (by 1 pupil) ❖ Low attainers: 6 pupils, 67% achieved at least expected progress in maths, below NA of 76%. ❖ Middle attainers: 12 pupils, 92% made at least expected progress in Maths, in line with NA. ❖ High attainers: 3 pupils, 100% made at least expected progress in Maths, above NA of 93%. <p>From eligible pupils: 22 pupil 59% made more than expected progress; this is above the Nat Ave of 34%</p>
Progress Measure – Writing	<p>From eligible pupils: 21 pupils</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 21 pupils, 95%, achieved at least expected progress in writing, this is in line with the NA. • Low attainers: 6 pupils, 100% made at least expected progress in writing, above NA of 87%. • Middle attainers: 12 pupils, 92% made at least expected progress in writing, slightly below NA of 96% (1 pupil) • High attainers: 3 pupils, 100% made at least expected progress in writing, above NA of 96%.

Narrowing the Gap: Pupil Premium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 11 pupils, 37% of cohort are classified as 'Disadvantaged' <p>Attainment In Reading the APS was 24.8: +0.9 below that of their peers (at 25.7) and below the Nat Ave of 29.6 by -4.8 APS. In Writing the APS was 25.9: 0.5 above that of their peers (at 25.4) but below the Nat Ave of 28.9 by -3.0 APS. In Math the APS was 26.5: -3.3 APS below that of their peers (at 29.8) and below the Nat Ave of 29.8. In SPAG the APS was 25.9: below that of their peers by -2.7 (at 28.6) and below NA of 29.9 by -4.0 APS.</p> <p>Progress In Reading 89% of Disadvantaged pupils made expected progress, below that of their peers (92%) and the National Average of 92% (by 1 pupil) In Writing 100% of pupils made expected progress, more than non-disadvantaged pupils where 92% made 2 levels progress. Progress of disadvantaged pupils was also above the National Average of 92% In Math 78% of Disadvantaged pupils made 2 levels of progress, below that of their peers (92%) and the National Average of 91%</p>
