Attendance news for Autumn 2: There will be an exciting treat at the end of every half term for all children who achieve at least 93% or above attendance.

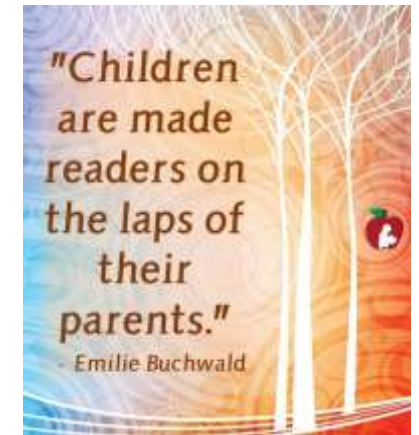
Let's work together to improve the attendance of all the Reception children

 - Please don't forget to go on an Autumn walk over the half term and fill up your bag with Autumn treasures and bring the bag back into school after half term.
